

The following chart applies to all staff and students regardless of vaccination status

Positive Test Results	Showing Symptoms	Exposed but Non-Symptomatic
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stay home for a minimum of 5 days from when symptoms started. ● AFTER 5 days, if you are symptom free, you may return to school/work while wearing a mask* for an additional 5 days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Test for COVID as soon as symptoms begin. ● If negative and symptom free, you may return to work/school. If positive, follow the requirements for a positive test. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● May return to school/work while wearing a mask* for 10 days. ● May test on day 5. If negative, you can stop wearing a mask. If positive, follow the requirements for a positive test.

**Families may opt to have a student stay home for the full 10 days for positive test or exposure if wearing a mask is an issue.*

Students, teachers, and staff who are sick with any illness will be expected to stay home and are encouraged to speak to their healthcare provider for possible testing and care. **Students will also be sent home if they are running a fever (100.4) or display any signs of cold or flu like symptoms.** At that point the "showing symptoms" part of the chart should be followed.
