

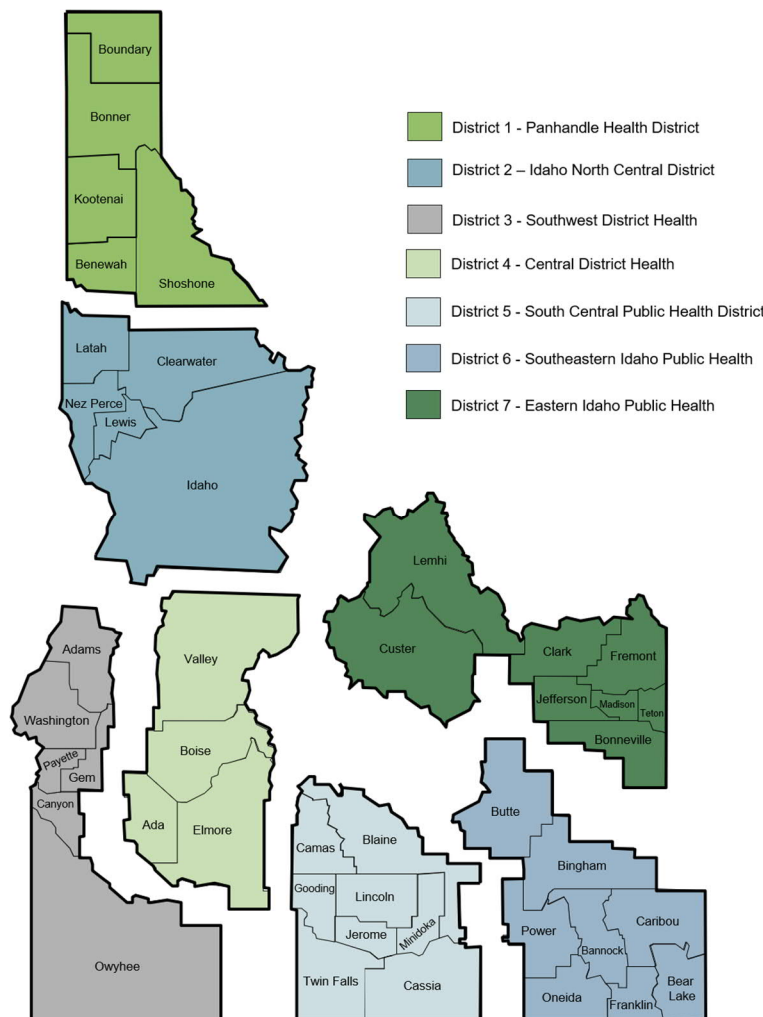
Dear Parents,

Idaho's statewide Stay-Home Order last Spring, and the subsequent stages of the Stay Healthy Order, encouraging residents to stay home as much as possible during the COVID-19 pandemic, have resulted in fewer pediatric visits to health care providers and few vaccines administered, leaving children at risk for vaccine-preventable diseases and communities at increased risk of outbreaks.

School vaccination requirements are critical to ensuring that students are protected. For Idaho's school immunization requirements, please see the [2020-2021 Parent's Guide to the School Immunization Requirements](#). We are encouraging catch-up vaccination for your child. Not meeting the school immunization requirements can lead to lower vaccination coverage and increased risk of outbreaks in schools.
